Important – Please Read

The following items are provided before the Jamboree by the Jamboree Organising Committee and the Queensland Contingent.

Jamboree Organising Committee*

2 x Official Jamboree badges – one to be placed on the Scout Uniform (**below** the Milestone badges on the right side of the uniform opposite the pocket).

1 x Jamboree Scarf 1 x

Jamboree woggle

1 x Jamboree Polo shirt

Queensland Contingent*

2 x Queensland Contingent badges (for swapping and NOT to be placed on the uniform)

1 x Queensland Name Tape – to be placed on the uniform (directly below your Group name tape)

1 x Queensland Contingent polo shirt 1 x

Backpack

1 x Water bottle 1

x Luggage tag

**The Jamboree and Queensland Contingent merchandise and any additional orders will be delivered to your (postal address) before the Jamboree.*

Merchandise returned by Australia Post due to invalid address details may be able to be collected from Queensland Contingent on 5th or 6th January 2025



Recommended Packing List

Please note that the below items are to be packed into **one** suitcase (46.5 x 83 x 31 cm) or **one** wheeled duffel bag (maximum 120 liters).

Each Queensland Contingent Member will be issued with a backpack that can be used as bus or cabin luggage – not to exceed 7kg.

No pocketknives, multitools with a blade or aerosols to be brought to the Jamboree

- Scout Uniform including Jamboree hat, scarf and woggle (to be worn to the Jamboree)
- Minimum 5 camp shirts, all with collars (preferred and sun safe)
- Minimum 5 pairs of shorts/skorts/skirts/culottes
- 2 pairs of sandshoes or joggers
- Old sandshoes or water shoes for water/mud activities
- Swimmers & sun shirt
- Jumper/light jacket/warm clothing (yes, it may be summer, but it can also get quite cool at night)
- Long trousers (jeans or slacks)
- Pyjamas or tracksuit
- Minimum 6 pairs of socks
- Minimum 6 pairs of underwear
- Handkerchiefs
- Toiletries Bag
 - Soap
 - Face washer
 - Deodorant
 - Toothbrush & toothpaste
 - Hairbrush and/or comb
 - Hair bands for those that use/need them
 - Shampoo (optional)
- Health Care Bag
 - Sunscreen
 - Lip balm
 - Insect repellent
 - Personal first aid kit
 - Foot powder
- Dilly Bag or Drawstring Bag (40cm x 40cm) – check with your JSL as some will provide plates and cutlery otherwise:
 - Plate
 - Bowl
 - Knife, fork, dessert spoon, teaspoon
 - Cup or Mug

NO Glass or ceramics – metal or plastic only NO Tea towels

- 2 towels – bath and beach)
- Sleeping bag and inner liner or bag (sheet folded lengthways and sewn at one end and along the length)
- Camp mattress (No stretchers) – 180cm x 65cm x 7.5cm
- 20 Clothes pegs (laundry detergent provided by the Contingent)
- Coat hanger (Uniform)
- Torch or headlamp with spare batteries
- 3 garbage bags for dirty or damp clothing/shoes
- Lunch box – note the back pack has a chiller pocket that will hold a lunch box

Cabin/Bus Luggage (Queensland Contingent Backpack)

- Photographic Identification (airport identification)
- Jumper/Jacket
- Raincoat
- Medication – blister packed
- Playing cards
- Book or magazine
- Snacks and lunch for the trip to Maryborough
- Contingent water bottle
- Swap badges
- Spending money/ATM Card
- Notebook & pen
- Inexpensive camera (optional)
- Watch (optional)
- Mobile phone (optional)

We discourage bringing expensive tablets, mobile phones, cameras, watches or other items that you do not want to risk losing or damaging.

A cheap camera and a watch from a discount store will do the job at the Jamboree

Mobile phones and other electronic distractions will be kept in a lock box during the Jamboree for security when not in use if brought to the Jamboree (refer webinar 24 November 2024)

Remember – clearly label EVERYTHING) that you bring to the Jamboree with your name and unit number, including items such as toothbrushes, sunscreen etc.

Lost property cannot be returned to you if it does not have a name on it.
